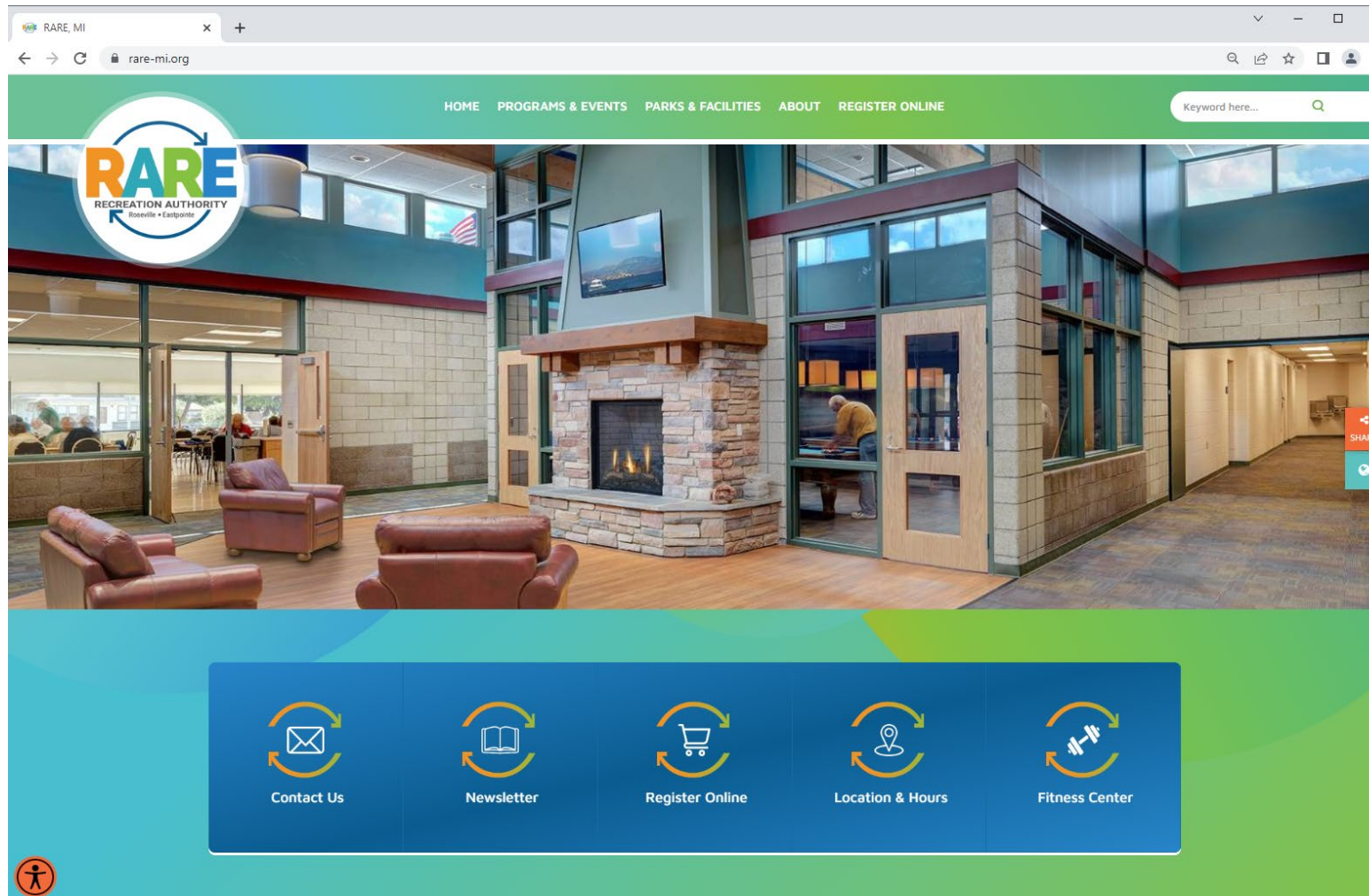

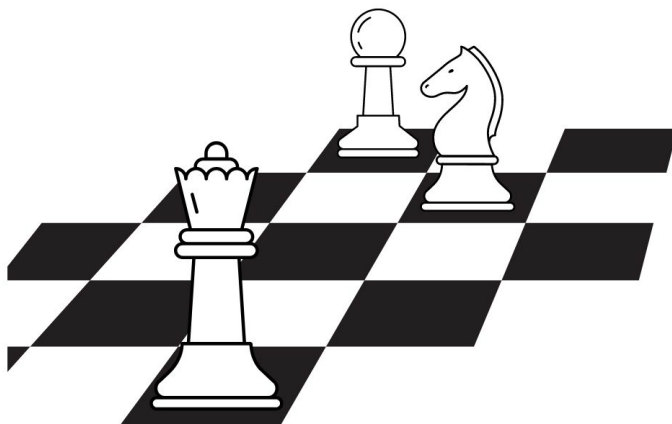
## TEEN CHESS CLUB
